Access to Care

A partnership with Stepping Stone Ministries was developed to ensure safe discharge for patients in precarious living conditions, further strengthened by a CommonSpirit Mission and Ministry Grant of nearly \$600,000 next three years, with program development planned for the upcoming fiscal year to directly address housing insecurity and improve patient outcomes.

Access to Care

Monthly support groups were hosted to address the needs of bariatric, cancer, and stroke patients, reaching approximately 20 individuals and providing a vital forum for shared experiences, emotional support, and improved coping mechanisms.

Health Related Social Needs

The BANQUET program served 395 individuals and, with a \$900 match of donated funds, effectively stocked two Little Food Pantries, directly combating food insecurity and providing accessible nourishment to vulnerable community members.

Awarded a \$100,000 Community Health Improvement Grant to develop a medical respite program in Bismarck to improve treatment outcomes by providing a recuperative community-based environment for patients experiencing homelessness.
