## Community Benefit Highlights\*\*



### Behavioral Health

Worked with the Dickinson Youth Commission, a voice for over 750 youth of all ages, in shaping their community and taking charge of their future.

### Community Support

Conducted formative work to launch a youth mentorship program. Our Community Health Worker connected with interested seniors, holding four quarterly workgroup meetings to advance this initiative.

### Affordable Housing

Secured partial funding to create transitional housing and emergency shelter in Dickinson, in partnership with the Southwest Area Homeless Coalition, United Way and the Corporation for Supportive Housing.

Awarded a nearly \$15,000 Community Health Improvement Grant to House of Manna, a nonprofit organization that provides clothing, food, and household items to individuals and families in need.
