

Car Seat Memo



Hospital policy requires infants to be discharged in a car seat. You will need to have your car seat or base installed **PRIOR** to coming to the hospital for delivery. OB staff **CANNOT** assist you with installing or securing your newborn in the car seat, as they are not trained or certified. Do not wait until time of discharge as staff cannot check for correct use and installation.



Car seat classes are offered by a car seat technician who can assist with car seat installation prior to delivery. Please visit CHStAlexiusHealth.org to register for a Car Seat Safety class.

If you cannot make it to a class offered at CHI St. Alexius Health Williston, you may schedule an appointment with a Child Passenger Safety (CPS) technician. Please call ahead, as schedules fill up fast.
