Gay Wallentine Memorial Scholarship

The Gay Wallentine Memorial Scholarship was established May 18, 1990 to provide financial assistance to eligible nursing students. It was setup by the family in memory of Gay Wallentine, former director of Critical Care Services. She died suddenly in February of 1990. Preference is given to nursing students who are interested in working at CHI St. Alexius Health.

Brita Eriksen Memorial Scholarship

The Brita Eriksen Memorial Scholarship was established by Dr. Johan Eriksen in memory of his wife, Brita. The scholarship is for students attending health education programs conducted by or associated with CHI St. Alexius Health. It's also offered to a CHI St. Alexius Health associate who is paying for their continuing education while employed at CHI St. Alexius Health. Such programs may include Radiology, Medical Technology, Anesthesiology and Respiratory Therapy.
