Visitor can travel from entrance door to room and back out only. Parent allowed to stay with pediatric child. Exceptions can be made for end of life care, patients with cognitive deficits or behavioral issues All Clergy administering the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick/Last Rites are able to visit. <p>Acute Care: in COVID isolation:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> No Visitors. Staff to use alternate form of visitation if able (zoom, face time, phone calls.) Exceptions may be made at the discretion of Management/Nursing for end of life care, pediatrics and pts with cognitive deficits or behavioral issues. If visitor is granted exception, must be over 18 yrs old. Clergy administering the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick/Last Rites are able to visit but asked to use discretion. Staff to ensure visit is requested by pt, no aerosol generating procedure is occurring and clergy is guided with donning and doffing PPE. <p>Imaging:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> OB Ultrasound: 1 visitor allowed <p>Clinic</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Limit the number of people accompanying a patient to their visit as able. <p>ER:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Limit the number of people accompanying an ER patient to a max of 2 at a given time. <p>All Visitors must pass the screening questions (be free of COVID-19 symptoms) and sign in/out.</p> <p>Masks ARE required at all times</p> <p>Social Distancing is strongly encouraged</p> | <p>Outpatient Procedures/Surgery</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 1 Visitor allowed to accompany the patient. <p>Acute Care: Non-COVID pt:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 1 visitor allowed to visit for 1 visit per day. Visitor can travel from entrance door to room and back out only. Parent allowed to stay with pediatric child.
