What Is BOTOX® Cosmetic?

First and only FDA approved product to temporarily improve both moderate to severe frown lines between the brows and crow's feet lines around the sides of the eyes.

How Does BOTOX® Cosmetic Work?

BOTOX® Cosmetic targets one of the underlying causes of frown lines and crow's feet—the repeated muscle contractions from frowning and squinting over the years. Your provider will inject these muscles with BOTOX® Cosmetic to temporarily reduce muscle activity. You'll begin to notice a visible smoothing of these lines.

How Is BOTOX® Cosmetic Administered?

To temporarily improve moderate to severe crow's feet, your provider will inject BOTOX® Cosmetic into the muscles surrounding the sides of your eyes, or in between your eyes, or your forehead with a series of small injections. BOTOX® Cosmetic is a quick, 10-minute procedure that requires very little downtime for recovery, if any.

What are the most common side effects?

Most common side effects are redness, swelling, possible bruising, and mild discomfort at injection site. Other possible side effects include eyelid drooping, dry mouth, tiredness, headache, neck pain, eye problems, dry eyes, and in rare cases allergic reaction.
