## Visitation & Appointment Information

### ***Before Your Appointment***

Please note the following information before coming in for your scheduled appointment:

- **Please wear a mask** to your appointment! Masks are required inside our facility. If you do not have your own mask, we will provide one.
- **Contact your provider ahead of time if you are experiencing COVID-19-type symptoms** including fever, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, headache, new loss of taste or smell, or diarrhea.
- Adhere to our **visitor restrictions** listed below if you plan to bring a visitor to your appointment.

### **All Visitors will be screened and must meet the following criteria:**

- Visitors must wear a mask AT ALL TIMES. Those who do not comply will be asked to leave the facility.
- Visitors must be free of respiratory concern including cough, fever, shortness of breath, or difficulty breathing.
- Visitors must NOT be a known/active positive for COVID-19 or have been exposed to COVID-19.

### ***Visitor Restrictions***

**Starting July 1, 2021** - Visitation Guidelines are as follows:

- **All hospital visitors must check in at the Emergency Room entrance**
- **Emergency Department & Hospital Inpatients** (Medical/Surgical/Pediatrics and Intensive Care Units)
  - Limited to 2 visitors at a time during visiting hours.
  - Visitors must wear a mask for entirety of visit
  - No age restrictions, but must be able to wear a mask and remain masked throughout visit.
  - No visitors are allowed for COVID-positive patients.
- **Obstetrics Unit**
  - Non-COVID-positive OB patients: Limited to 2 support persons (age 18 and older) throughout the patient's entire stay.
    - In addition to the patient's 2 support persons, patients are allowed 2 additional visitors at a time during visiting hours 4p—7p. No age restrictions, but must be able to wear a mask and remain masked throughout visit.
  - COVID-positive OB patients: Limited to 1 support person (age 18 and older) throughout the patient's entire stay, with the support person rooming with the patient.
    - Infants will be allowed their parents.
- **COVID Screening Clinic** – No visitors are allowed unless the patient is under 18 or requires a full time support person.
